Emmanuel United Church of Christ, located at 124 Broadway, is providing 30 minute tours at 10 a.m., 11 a.m. and 12 p.m. Designed by John Dempwolf, and dedicated in 1904, the Gothic-style sanctuary includes stained and painted glass windows, a rose window, hand-stenciled plaster, oak woodwork, vaulted wooden ceiling, and 54-rank pipe organ. The stained glass window behind the marble alter depicts the figure of Christ and was made by the Louis Comfort Tiffany studio.
